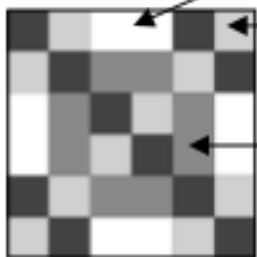

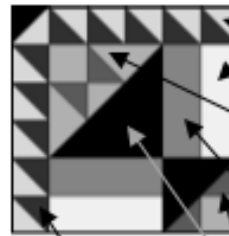

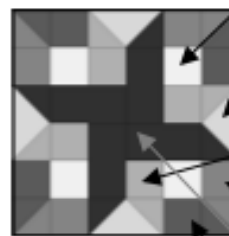

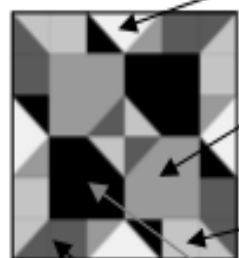

### Borders & Sashing

The pattern was designed to use a scrappy border. We encourage shops to provide the Light fabric for sashing strips & 1st border, and Dark fabric cornerstones. Have quilters cut the remaining Light, Medium & Dark from their scraps, or sell yardage indicated for planned outer border.

1-7/8 yard total  
Light

(1-3/8 needed for sashing, cornerstones & 1st border)

1-3/4 yard total  
Medium  
(7/8 yard needed for binding)

1-1/8 yard total  
Dark  
(14" strip of 2 fabrics needed for Cornerstones)
